- Students who qualify for the Scholastic Award need apply **once only** for the first time.
- The Award is applicable on semester basis, *i.e.*, the tuition fee remission is only effective for one semester.
- The Award is **only** offered in January & May semesters. Qualified students need to apply with January semester's result for the Award in May semester, and to combine May & September semesters' result to apply for the Award in January semester. However, new students who enrol into the Degree programme in September semester are eligible to use their September's results to apply for the Award in January semester.
- Students who fail to meet the requirements for the subsequent semesters will be terminated from the Award automatically. However, they may re-qualify themselves at a later date by meeting the academic requirements stated.
- Scholastic Award recipients will be required to take part in MPI organized activities such as Open Day, Career Fair, promotional activities, student self study session, seminars as and when required by the Institute.
- In the event that the recipient withdraws from the program, is suspended or expelled by the Institute, at any point of time before completing the programme, this award shall automatically be revoked.
